

Course of Study Book Service - Procedure for Obtaining Books

The Tennessee Conference Fellowship of Local Pastors and Associate Members maintains a service for Course of Study students who need to obtain their textbooks for free or for the cost of shipping. Books are donated by students, faculty, and others and are then loaned to other students.

Go to the Fellowship's website: <http://tnflpam.wikispaces.com/home> to see which books are available for loan, click on "COS Books Available" on the left.

Procedure for obtaining books:

1. Check the "COS Books Available" link on the left to be sure that the books you need are available.
2. Send a list of books you want to borrow by email to cosbooks.tnflpam@gmail.com.
3. If you want to pick up your books in Murfreesboro, let us know in your email. There will be no cost to you.
4. If you want the books shipped, let us know in your email and we will send a PayPal "Request for Payment" to the email address you used to send your list.
5. Follow the instructions in the email to pay for shipping costs.
6. Your books will be mailed as soon as possible after payment is confirmed and you will receive an email confirming shipment with a way to track the shipment.

NOTES:

- PayPal is a safe, easy way to pay. You do not have to set up an account but you will need a credit or debit card. You may also use electronic checking but this causes a delay until the check clears.
- We use USPS Media Mail, the least expensive way of shipping but also the slowest (2-8 business days according to USPS). If you need faster delivery, let us know. Priority Mail delivery is 1-3 business days but is more expensive. Express Mail is overnight but is very expensive. Go to www.usps.com to compare rates.
- We would also encourage churches and individuals to donate needed books. Donated books may be brought or sent to Earl Davis, PO Box 6, Leoma, TN 38468.
