Directions to Union College & Registration:

Union college is located 17 miles east of I-75 at the Corbin/Barbourville exit (#29 at US 25E)

From I-75: Exit at #29 and travel east on US 25E for 17 miles

After you enter the Barbourville area, turn right at Daniel Boone Drive (KY 11)

At the second stoplight turn right onto Cumberland Ave.

Continue through the next stop light onto College Street

Pass the front of Union College on the right

Turn right onto Manchester Street, Chapel parking lot is on your right. Go past it and take next right Park by the track and enter the back of the Patridge Campus Center Building to Register
